Dear Texas Eagles,

When I returned from Eagle Council a few weeks ago, my mind was overflowing with new and refreshed information. Each year, Eagle Council puts together a fabulous program of speakers and subject-matter experts covering dozens of critical issues. Attendees learn important facts and new strategies to add to their arsenals when dealing with lawmakers on these issues back in their home states. With every year I've attended Eagle Council, I find myself empowered and encouraged, despite the daunting reports of the direction in which our nation is headed.

I was particularly interested in Eagle Forum president Kris Ullman's presentation where she shared clear evidence that several of Kamala Harris's talking points are direct references to former Communist leaders. "Unburdened by what has been" is a Communist rallying cry similar to Mao's "four olds." Chinese Communists believed that "old" ideas, culture, customs, and habits had to be destroyed in order to usher in the Marxist utopia. Whenever I hear the word "democracy" applied to our unique Republic, I cringe. I can't help but correct the speaker, even if it's said on TV. But the Left has been trying to make us a democracy for a long time by co-opting language in order to deceive Americans into believing that individuals should be ruled by the community rather than the other way around.

Our duty is to understand the issues that we are facing both as Texans and as Americans. Our goal is to equip you to successfully discuss these issues where you can. During each legislative session, you help us speak the truth about the issues we support or oppose, share the impact each will have on Texans, good or bad, and pray we are heard. So, in this month's Torch, we are glad to provide you with a taste of what we heard at Eagle Council 52, and we hope it will help you in your own conversations and activism.

Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton has recently won a case protecting our law against vote harvesting and is working with other state AG's to demand compliance with Federal Law to stop noncitizens from voting. AG Paxton is also protecting Texas doctors' and hospitals' right to refuse to provide abortions prohibited by state law. And AG Paxton is suing a doctor in Texas for providing harmful "gender transition" treatments to children in Texas.

I cannot emphasize it enough: the work we are doing together, on behalf of conservative values in Texas, does make a difference!
