## Resolution - Oppose Medical, Decriminalized and Legalized Marijuana

Plank 256 as currently written in the RPT platform is designed to join the destructive Left to move Texas down the road toward legalization.

In the 87<sup>th</sup> session, Legislators passed HB 1535 which doubled the amount of THC allowed in "medical marijuana." The bill expanded the "Compassionate-Use Program" to patients with ALL forms of cancer and patients with post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and raised the maximum level of THC from 0.5% to 1%.

Multiple studies have shown that marijuana use elevates the symptoms of PTSD.
